

Music Crypto-Families with Hints

Crypto-families are lists of related words that are encrypted with a letter substitution. In this case, all the lists are related to music. Each list uses a different letter substitution. An example of a letter substitution encryption is like this: The word MUSIC could be encoded to ABCDE if M=A, U=B, S=C, I=D, C=E.
