

HOMEBOUND INSTRUCTION

The Ringwood Board of Education is aware of the need to provide instruction for students who, for medical reasons, are not able to attend school. Therefore, the district will provide homebound instruction, as approved by the State Board of Education, for students who are unable to attend school. The handicapping disability must be certified by a medical doctor and homebound instruction approved by the board of education on an individual case basis.

Grades awarded by homebound teachers will be of the same value as the grades awarded by other teachers.

Requests for homebound instruction will be made to the superintendent. If the request is approved, a teacher will visit the student at home or in the hospital in accordance with the superintendent's procedures for homebound instruction.
