The label must reflect the name, strength, and dosage of the medication and whether or not the medication may be self-administered by a minor. Non-prescription medication must be in the original container that must reflect the name and strength of the medication.

This form must be signed by the parent/guardian of the child named herein. The signature of the prescribing physician may be required at the discretion of the medication administrator.
